## Guidelines:

- 1. Applications must be submitted within 6 months of purchase date.**
2. Rebates are only available to City Utilities electric and/or natural gas customers.
3. The rebated thermostat must be installed on a premise served by City Utilities.
4. The applicant must be the customer of record for an active, non-delinquent account.
5. Rebate will not exceed the thermostat purchase price.
6. Rebates are limited to two per residential customer and up to six for new construction, commercial and multi-family customers, during each program year (October through September). Rebates are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis until program funds have been depleted.
- 7. Copies of installer invoices and/or itemized purchase receipts, original programmable thermostat UPC code (unless contractor-installed), and the model number must be submitted along with a completed application form.**

8. Failure to provide required information may result in denial of rebate.
9. Participants in this program must agree to properly dispose of old thermostats containing mercury.
10. City Utilities reserves the right to inspect the installed rebated material. If such site does not have the qualifying equipment installed, the rebate may be debited to the electric or natural gas account.
11. **City Utilities reserves the right to amend or discontinue this program without notice.**
