

EFFICIENT TOILET REBATE PROGRAM APPLICATION FORM

City Utilities water customers who replace existing toilets are eligible

for a \$50 rebate after the purchase and installation of an Ultra Low-Flow Toilet, or a \$75 rebate after the purchase and installation of a High Efficiency Toilet that has the WaterSense label. For new homes and businesses under construction, customers who choose a High Efficiency Toilet with the WaterSense label are eligible for the \$75 rebate. Ultra Low-Flow Toilets use 1.6 gallons of water per flush (gpf) – and is the standard for all toilets manufactured since 1994. High Efficiency Toilets use 1.28 gpf or less. Toilets manufactured earlier than January 1, 1994, use between 3.5 to 7 gpf. By participating in this rebate program, you could save approximately 6,000 gallons of water per year, while at the same time knowing you are doing your part to conserve water. *Certain restrictions apply; see Guidelines.*

1. Purchase an Ultra Low-Flow or Hig Efficiency WaterSense labeled toilet.
2. Install the new toilet.
 - If professional installation is needed, City Utilities recommends getting at least 2-3 different bids. For information on how to select a qualified contractor or view the City Utilities Contractor List, visit www.cuenergywise.com.
3. **Submit the following information:**
 - ✓ **Application form**
 - ✓ **Copies of invoices and/or sales receipts**
 - ✓ **Toilet Brand and Model Number**
4. The rebate will be processed within 3-5 weeks after the properly submitted application and information is received.

- Guidelines:**
1. **Applications must be submitted within 6 months of purchase date.**
 2. City Utilities residential and/or commercial water customers who replace existing tank-type toilets are eligible for a \$50 rebate after the purchase and installation of an Ultra Low-Flow Toilet, or a \$75 rebate after the purchase and installation of a High Efficiency Toilet with the WaterSense label.
 3. New homes and businesses under construction are eligible for a \$75 rebate, after the purchase and installation of a High Efficiency Toilet with the WaterSense label rated at 1.28 or less gallons per flush. To qualify for the rebate, the new home or business must be a City Utilities water customer. (New construction projects are not eligible for the Ultra Low-Flow Toilet rebate, because 1.6 gpf is the standard for all toilets manufactured since 1994).
 4. **Residential customers may receive up to three (3) rebates per service address. Commercial customers may receive up to six (6) rebates per service address.**
 5. Toilet purchase must include both bowl and tank, and be installed at the service address listed on the application.
 6. Applicant must be the customer of record for an active, non-delinquent account.
 7. A completed Efficient Toilet Rebate Application is required. The application must include the manufacturer and model number of the toilet purchased.
 8. Rebate will not exceed the toilet purchase price.
 9. Customer must submit a dated, detailed invoice/sales receipt as proof of purchase.
 10. Old toilets must not be reused. Participants agree to destroy or disable their old toilets, and dispose of properly. City Utilities encourages recycling, if possible.
 11. Failure to provide required information may result in denial of the rebate.
 12. Rebates are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis until program funds have been depleted.

- 13. City Utilities reserves the right to inspect the installed rebated material. If such site does not have the qualifying equipment installed, the amount rebated may be debited back to the account.
