### **CITY UTILITIES OF SPRINGFIELD RECEIVES NATIONAL AWARD FOR ENHANCING PRESTIGE OF PUBLIC POWER**

WASHINGTON, D.C., June 21, 2011 — City Utilities of Springfield, Mo., received the American Public Power Association's (APPA) E.F. Scattergood System Achievement Award at the Association's national conference in Washington, D.C. This award honors APPA member systems that have enhanced the prestige of public power utilities through sustained achievement and customer service.

City Utilities first won the Scattergood award in 1990. Since that time, the utility has constructed a new major base-load generating unit, achieved platinum RP3 recognition, demonstrated leadership in the Missouri Carbon Sequestration Project, and participated in the largest biomass generation test in North America.

Since 1990, the system has also improved outage reporting, management systems and automated metering. City Utilities has developed energy efficiency programs for its customers, implementing 16 new rebate and incentive programs.
