**NOTICE OF 2018 TRANSMISSION FORMULA RATE UPDATE MEETING**

**Annual Update Information Posted**

City Utilities of Springfield, Missouri's (hereinafter "City Utilities") Transmission Formula Rate was approved by the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission on June 5, 2015, with an effective date of April 1, 2015. See FERC Docket No. ER15-964. On February 1, 2018, City Utilities posted its Annual Update that recalculates the Annual Transmission Revenue Requirement ("ATRR"), zonal Point-to-Point ("PTP") and Schedule 1 service for the new rate year. The Annual Update includes a workable populated formula template with fully functional spreadsheets showing the calculation of the Annual Update and underlying work papers in native format with links and formulas intact, including sufficiently detailed work papers and supporting documentation for data. The update is based on the independently-audited books and records of City Utilities for the most recent fiscal year (October 1 through September 30).
