1. Install a NEMA 6-50 or NEMA 14-50 outlet in the attached garage of a residential new construction dwelling.
2. Verify the outlet is connected and operational.
3. Complete the application form.
4. Provide a copy of the receipt or contractor's invoice with an itemized listing of the outlet and installation cost and date.

*Please allow 3-5 weeks to receive approved rebate.*

## Guidelines

1. **Application must be submitted within 90 days of purchase and installation date.**
2. Residential **new construction** dwellings with an attached garage and City Utilities electric service are eligible for an EV-Ready Home rebate of up to \$100, not to exceed the outlet and installation cost.
3. Outlet must be installed during the building process, be connected and operational prior to occupancy.
4. Customers may receive up to two (2) rebates per service address.
5. The applicant must be the customer of record for the temporary electric service.
6. The installation must include a 50-amp branch circuit equipped with a NEMA 6-50 or NEMA 14-50 receptacle to accept a Level 2 electric vehicle (EV) charger.
7. **Copies of installer itemized invoice must be submitted along with a completed rebate application form.**
8. Failure to provide required information may result in denial of the rebate.
9. Rebates are awarded on a first-come, first-served basis until program funds have been depleted.
10. The applicant agrees that work completed complies with all federal, state, and local safety, building, electrical and environmental codes. All necessary permits and/or inspections are the responsibility of the customer.
11. City Utilities is not responsible for the performance of the outlet, and does not provide any warranties, expressed or implied.
12. City Utilities reserves the right to inspect the installed rebated material. If such does not have the qualifying equipment installed, the rebate may be debited to the electric account.
13. **City Utilities reserves the right to amend or discontinue this program without notice.**
